## COUNCIL STANDING COMMITTEES SCOPES AND AUTHORITIES

### **BUDGET, FINANCE, AND ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE**

The Budget, Finance and Administration Committee, in conjunction with City Staff, may consider matters related to the financial issue of the City, including the annual and capital budgets including revenues and expenditures, sales of bonds, general fiscal and financial conditions, voucher approval, rates and fees, audit and operations of the City, including but not limited to, facilities and properties computerization, periodic budget and financial reports, and policy matters related to personnel, in coordination with the finance and administration departments.

### **PLANNING AND COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMITTEE**

The Planning and Community Services Committee, in conjunction with City Staff, may consider matters of a non-quasi-judicial nature related to community growth and development, including but not limited to, planning of the physical, economic, aesthetic and social development of the City, comprehensive plan, zoning code, housing, annexation policies, and code enforcement. This committee may also consider matters not included in other committee's scopes of authority. In conjunction with City Staff, the committee may consider matters related to planning and implementation of parks and recreational facilities, the capital improvements program, and trails.

### **PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE**

The Public Safety Committee, in conjunction with City Staff, may consider issues related to the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Black Diamond including but not limited to, law enforcement, fire safety, court, hazardous materials, animal control, special events and emergency services.

### **PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE**

The Public Works Committee, in conjunction with City Staff, may consider matters related to water, sewer, solid waste, recycling, utility franchises, storm water management, transportation, the capital improvement program, transit, streets, street lighting, signalization and street local improvement, and cemetery.
